Guide Line.

Avant de commencer tu DOIS avoir :

- Une liste de **4-6 amis** de ton héros
- Des **commentaires** faits par les amis de ton héros, que tu placeras sous les « posts »
- Des **photos** de ton héros, de ses amis et de quelques uns des principaux endroits, ou événements de sa vie. Ou toute autre photo que tu juges importante.



Puis tu peux commencer à faire les différents « posts ». ATTENTION, tu dois les inscrire dans l'ordre ANTE-CHRONOLOGIQUE !!! le plus récent d'abord !

Exemple avec Shakespeare :
